GOD'S ACTION | OUR RESPONSE

Notice at least 2 things about our service shape:

1) We rehearse the Gospel:

The service takes us through the Gospel...who our God is, our need for him, his provision for salvation in and through Jesus, our response

2) It is a dialogue between God and his people: God acts/speaks and we respond

- We prepare for Worship
- We greet God and one another
- God Calls us to Worship
- We pray for God to help us worship
- We sing songs of Adoration
- We Affirm our Faith
- God Calls us to Confess
- We Confess our Individual and Corporate Sins
- God Declares our Forgiveness
- We respond and sing songs of thanksgiving
- We pray for the reading/preaching of God's word
- We welcome one another in the Lord's name
- God speaks to us in his word instructing, correcting, comforting, inspiring, encouraging
- We listen with reception and repentance
- We offer ourselves through offerings and praise
- God invites us to his table
- We feast at the Lord's table
- God blesses us and sends us out
- We Praise God
